We look forward to welcoming all new and returning sailors in June. Until then, wishing all fair winds and calm seas.

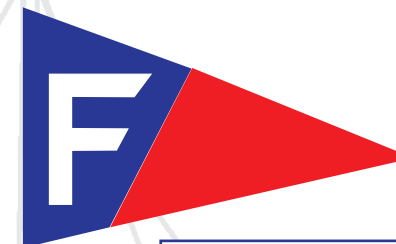

RACE COMMITTEE REPORT

The 2010 FYC racing season will begin at 1300 on Saturday, June 19 with three Sonar races. New owner Ryan Richards has joined current owners Jack Vallee, Josh Rolkoff, Joe Voci and Eric Sundquist/Bruce Levy to increase the fleet size to five active boats. In addition to the traditional local racing series, the Sonar fleet will invite Sonars from Cape Cod, Buzzards Bay and the North Shore to participate in the Mid-Summer Regatta on July 17 and 18. A large fleet is expected. Local Sonar owners will also participate in the Vineyard Haven Sonar Regatta in August.

The Falmouth 420 Regatta is scheduled for July 24 and 25. The Falmouth Regatta will also serve as the Area "A" qualifying event for the Bemis Trophy – the US Sailing double-handed championship. A fleet of approximately 100 boats is expected.

The PHRF Just-For-Fun Race also returns on August 14. As it was last year, JFF will be a pursuit race with a course length of approximately 5 – 10 miles around government buoys in Vineyard Sound. Handicaps will be loosely based upon the ratings of the New England PHRF organization.

The 2010 racing schedule is not complete at this time. It will be posted on the FYC website when it is available.

After receiving a complete bottom job and many needed repairs in 2009, the RC boat is in excellent condition and should need very little additional maintenance before launching.

The Race Committee is always looking for volunteers to help run races. It doesn't matter if you've never run races before. The RC will teach you everything you need to know. It helps if you know how to sail, but it's not necessary. If you are interested in helping, please let club manager Greg Silva know.
