The dictionary definition of bagel is: A glazed, ring-shaped roll with a tough, chewy texture, made from plain yeast dough that is dropped briefly into nearly boiling water and then baked. A refreshing breeze came rolling down Falmouth Heights, gently sweeping the 420s, Lasers, and Optimists off the beach and into the welcoming embrace of their respective racing areas, across the Sound. Although somewhat overcast and cool, like the old days of summer on Cape Cod, the fleets enjoyed 5 races to qualify for a throw out in the series. Good thing, too because on the second day all felt transported to a sultry paradise, presented with light air, clear skies and a hot sun. Same Cape Cod, next day, a whole "nother" thing indeed.
